Preparation

Fellowship

Open in prayer.

Icebreaker: Go round the group and let each person give a 1-minute life update. Keep it fast paced.

Worship

Some songs of faith and trust, and surrender will be wonderful for the start of the term.

Discipleship

1. Set the scene by reading the introduction in the sermon recap to your group. Then ask someone to read John 15:5 and discuss this verse.
2. Read Galatians 5:22-26 and highlight that each of the 9 fruit is produced by the Holy Spirit. Ask each person to share which of the 9 fruit they would like to see more of in their life in the second part of the year.
3. Talk about the fruit of love and highlight the difference between Agape love and the world's definition of love. Ask someone to share a testimony of where they interacted with someone with Agape love and what happened.
4. Read Nehemiah 8:10 and Psalm 51:12. Ask a few people to share about someone they know who displays the fruit of joy.
5. We live in world of stress and strife. Discuss how we as Christians, with the fruit of peace in our hearts, can bring peace into the places God sends us.

Ministry

Share prayer needs and pray for one another.

Evangelism

Ask the Lord to lay on your heart an unsaved person. Commit to praying for them on a weekly basis for the rest of the year.
